ORDER REMOVING ALL RESTRICTIONS

THIS MATTER came on regularly for consideration on September 20, 2018, before the Mississippi State Board of Medical Licensure, in response to the request of James Leonard Holzhauer, M.D. (hereinafter "Licensee"), seeking removal of all restrictions on his license to the practice medicine in the State of Mississippi. By virtue of that certain Order dated July 19, 2018, certain restrictions were imposed on Licensee's certificate to practice medicine in the state of Mississippi; said restrictions prohibiting Licensee from practicing obstetrics whether on an inpatient or outpatient basis. The Board is now advised that Licensee is semi-retired and is limiting his medical practice to gynecology and general medicine. Licensee has advised his staff, patients and hospitals wherein he currently holds medical privileges of his voluntary limited practice. Based on this announcement, therefore, the Board after hearing said request finds the same to be well-taken.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Licensee's request for removal of all restrictions on his license to practice medicine is hereby granted, effective November 21, 2018, at which time Licensee will then hold an unrestricted license to practice medicine in the State of Mississippi.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. Section 73-25-27, a copy of this Order shall be sent by registered mail or personally served upon James Leonard Holzhauer, M.D.
