Dear Dr. Wang:

I appreciate you meeting with the Executive Committee (EC) on November 13, 2019. The purpose of your attendance was to address your practice of Chelation Therapy. The Board was made aware of your practicing Chelation Therapy for the purpose of removing heavy metal, which is not prohibited according to the rules and regulations. We are also aware of your performing Chelation Therapy as part of a trial. Although trials are important for the advancement of treatment and medicine as a whole, active participation in a chelation therapy trial is prohibited without prior approval from the Board. Further, you also admitted your use of chelation therapy outside the trial and not for removal of heavy metals, which is expressly prohibited at this time. The Board stated you are not to treat patients outside of the FDA approved protocol.

As stated at the meeting, the Board decided you may continue to participate in the TACT trial. However, due to the listed violations that have been committed, the Board has also decided to issue you this **public letter of concern** related to the performance of Chelation Therapy outside of the trial and without prior authorization from the Board. The Board also strongly suggested that you take a Board certified CME course in Ethics, and a copy of the Board certified CME courses will be included with this letter.

The Board does not consider a public letter of concern to be a limitation or restriction on your license. The Board urges you to take steps to ensure that such deficiencies do not recur. In the event of recurrence, the Board will commence formal disciplinary proceedings which could result in formal disciplinary action against your license to practice medicine.
