LETTER OF REPRIMAND

The above-titled matter came before the Mississippi State Board of Medical Licensure (hereinafter "Board") in Jackson, Hinds County, Mississippi, on March 25, 2021, pursuant to a Summons and Affidavit issued to Shawn Xuan Wu, M.D. (hereinafter "Licensee"). A quorum of Board members was present throughout the proceeding.

Board Counsel Stan Ingram, Esq., presented the charges as set forth in the Affidavit as filed herein. Licensee, having been served with the Summons and being fully informed of his rights to a formal hearing before the Board, was represented by Joel Howell, Esq. and Donald Rafferty, Esq. The Presiding Officer was Alexis Morris, Esq., Special Assistant Attorney General.

Following opening statements from counsel, and in lieu of a formal hearing, it was the decision of the Board with consent of Licensee and his counsel to resolve the pending matter without adjudication of the merits, by entry of a Letter of Reprimand with conditions attached, all pursuant to Sections 73-25-29, 73-25-83 and 73-25-87 of the <u>Miss. Code Ann</u>. (1972) as amended.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Shawn Xuan Wu, M.D., holder of Mississippi Medical License No. 18988, is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within a period of one (1) year from the date of this Order, Licensee shall complete Board approved Continuing Medical Education courses (CME) in the areas of (i) prescribing of controlled substances, (ii) boundaries and (iii) ethics. After completion of each CME, Licensee shall submit to the Board documentary proof of successful completion thereof. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Licensee shall reimburse Board for all costs incurred in relation to the pending matter pursuant to <u>Miss. Code Ann</u>. Section 73-25-30. Licensee shall be advised of the total assessment, not to exceed \$10,000, by written notification, and shall tender to the Board a certified check or money order within forty (40) days after the date the assessment is mailed to Licensee via US mail to Licensee's current mailing address.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Licensee fails to complete the CME as required herein or violates any of the laws, rules and regulations governing the practice of medicine, the Board may take further disciplinary action against Licensee.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Letter of Reprimand shall be deemed a public record. It may be shared with other licensing boards (in and out of state), and the public, and may be reported to the appropriate entities as required or authorized by state and/or federal law or guidelines. This action shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board as its official act and deed.
