**ORDER REMOVING RESTRICTIONS**

---

THIS MATTER came on regularly for hearing on March 18, 2026, before the Mississippi State Board of Medical Licensure (hereinafter “Board”), in response to the unopposed *Ore Tenus* Motion of Timothy Dale Jackson, M.D. (hereinafter “Licensee”), seeking removal of all restrictions on his license to practice medicine in the State of Mississippi.

On November 18, 2021, the Board reinstated Licensee’s Mississippi medical license, but restricted his surgical privileges until the Licensee participated in and successfully completed a Board-approved reentry program. On January 4, 2022, Licensee and Dr. Ken Cleveland, Executive Director, executed a “MSBML Practice Requirements and Agreement” (“Agreement”),” which set forth the requirements for the Licensee’s reentry program. The Agreement required Licensee to enter into a formal proctoring relationship with a physician actively practicing in his specialty. The agreement established three “periods” or phases. Licensee appeared before the Board on January 15, 2026 requesting the Board to remove the restrictions on his

licensure prior to completing the agreed upon reentry program. Licensee testified that he was not able to obtain the necessary credentialing at the hospital that employs him because of the surgery restriction on his license. As such, Licensee was unable to complete the reentry program. The Board, in denying his request, advised the Licensee to look at other options to satisfy the reentry program requirements.

On March 18, 2026, Licensee appeared before the Board and was represented by Honorable William Whitfield. Counsel for the Board was Honorable Paul Barnes. Sitting as legal advisor and hearing officer to the Board was Honorable Sara Hartzog, Special Assistant Attorney General. Board members present for the proceedings were Ken Lippincott, M.D., President; Michelle Owens, M.D., Vice-President; Roderick Givens, M.D., Secretary; Kirk Kinard, D.O.; Carlos Latorre, M.D. and Allen Gersh, M.D. Once again, Licensee sought removal of restrictions from licensure. He testified that the Board's Executive Director, Dr. Ken Cleveland, brokered an arrangement wherein if the Board would agree to remove all restrictions on Dr. Jackson's license, then CPEP would agree to oversee the remaining phases of his reentry program. Licensee executed the contract with CPEP prior to the hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee's request for removal of restrictions is hereby granted. Licensee now holds an unrestricted license to practice medicine in the State of Mississippi, subject to the completion of the CPEP reentry program.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to MISS. CODE ANN. Section 73-25-27, that a copy of this Order shall be sent by registered mail or personally served upon TIMOTHY DALE JACKSON, M.D.
