Rhonda Freeman, Bureau Director, Licensure Division advised the Executive Committee that by regulation an application becomes null and void after one year. Dr. Morgan's application will be at the 12 month mark before she can take the examination for certification.

The Executive Committee unanimously agreed to extend Dr. Morgan's licensure application until such time that she has obtained the examination results and will take into advisement of granting a waiver of this requirement to issue a permanent medical license in lieu of an examination.

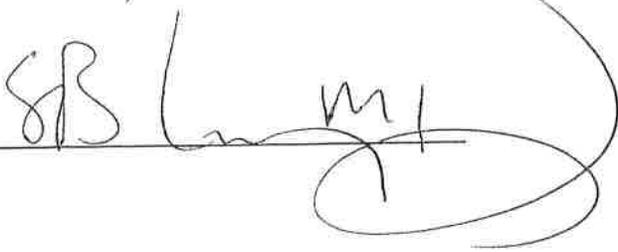
