Dr. Munech joined the meeting. Drs. Williams and Kroll were not present. Dr. Munech, one of the owners of Comprehensive Pain Specialists (CPS) was represented by legal counsel, Julie Mitchell. Dr. Munech executed a written agreement for this informal meeting, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Following introductions, Dr. Miles asked Dr. Munech to discuss the status of the pain practices located in Southaven and Oxford, MS. Ms. Mitchell advised the previous Medical Director had left the practice in August and CPS is currently seeking a qualified replacement. Dr. Munech is requesting a two month extension of the pain practice certificate utilizing temporary physicians from other practices until a qualified replacement has been found.

Following several questions, a motion was made by Dr. Easterling, seconded by Dr. Miles and carried that the Executive Committee enter into Executive Session discuss a matter that may affect the Licensee.

Upon a motion by Dr. Easterling, seconded by Dr. Miles and carried the Executive Committee came out of Executive Session at which time Dr. Miles asked Dr. Rea to report on its decision. Dr. Rea advised that the Executive Committee will recommend that the request for an extension of the pain practice certificate for the CPS practices at the Southaven and Oxford locations should be denied.

Dr. Wood joined the meeting and was not represented by legal counsel. Dr. Wood executed a written agreement for this informal meeting, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Following introductions, Dr. Miles asked Dr. Wood to discuss his prescribing of controlled substances in his practice. Dr. Wood advised that he is not a pain practice but he treats provides pain management in the normal course of his practice. Dr. Wood was asked to discuss his documentation of controlled substance prescribing and prescribing the combination of opioids and benzodiazepines. Dr. Wood advised that the patient records are recorded electronically and that he does prescribe the combination of opioids and benzodiazepine when medically necessary with the appropriate warning and counsel to his patients.

Dr. Wood was advised that after a recent investigation and patient chart review that no prescription monitoring profiles were documented for patients that were receiving controlled substance prescriptions. It was pointed out that Wood's prescribing history indicated large volumes of controlled substance issued in potentially dangerous combinations.

After further discussion and additional questions from the Executive Committee, a motion was made by Dr. Rea, seconded by Dr. Miles and carried that the Executive Committee enter into Executive Session to discuss pending investigation.

Upon a motion by Dr. Easterling, seconded by Dr. Miles and carried the Executive Committee came out of Executive Session at which time Dr. Miles asked Dr. Rea to report on its decision. Dr. Rea advised that the Executive Committee will recommend to the Board that Licensee will take a Board approved prescribing course and his prescribing will be reviewed. This is to be presented in a non-reportable, non-disciplinary consent order.

Mr. Ingram advised that Singing River notified the Board of Licensee's voluntary resignation following restrictions placed on his hospital privileges in which Licensee agreed to not treat or admit patients for Multiple Sclerosis (MS). Dr. Millette stated that was correct. Licensee was requested to discuss the action by Singing River Hospital in regards to his treatment of MS patients and prescribing of controlled substances in his neurology practice.

Mr. Ingram pointed out there may be a question this Consent Order may restrict Dr. Wadsworth's ability to collaborate with med-level providers. The Executive Committee advised Licensee that Mr. Ingram will communicate with Licensee after further investigation, if the Consent Order prohibits him from collaborating with mid-level providers.

Pending further review, PA Guillo's protocol was approved.
